FROM DENTURES TO BRIDGES



Until now, the loss of teeth meant wearing a full denture or partial denture with the possibility of the following consequences: Poor fitting dentures, especially in the lower jaw, limited chewing function, reduced sense of taste, sometimes involuntary gag reflex or distorted pronunciation (phonics).

The denture exerts continuous pressure on the jawbone. This can provoke further bone loss and poor fitting of the denture. Removable dentures are an insufficient support for the facial tissue. This can result in premature wrinkles and aging appearance.

With more sophisticated construction (4-10 implants per jaw) it is possible to place a fixed implant bridge. Implants have a bone maintaining effect: Bone atrophy doesn't occur even under chewing pressure. The good lip support provides a harmonic facial profile and taut skin
